



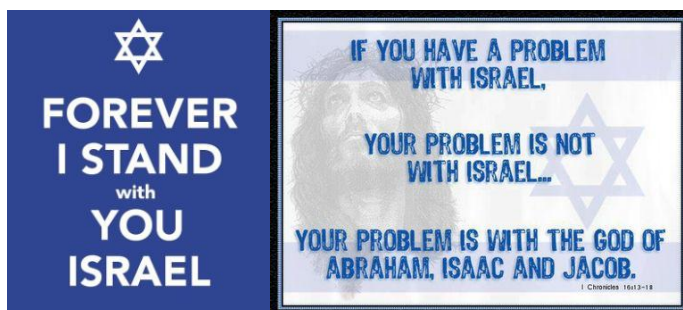
90 – 95% (if not more) of Christendom says...
